Admission Test Rules

Admission to all classes except pre-primary classes is granted on the basis of a test conducted by the school on the date and time notified separately, provided the student satisfies the eligibility conditions laid down by the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh and H.P. Board of School Education, Dharamshala. The main objective of the admission test is to assess the level of learning and aptitude of the student. Brief information regarding admission tests is as follows :

Subject Combinations

For classes XI and XII

(i) Non-medical stream : Phy, Chem, Maths, Informatics Practices, English.

(ii) Medical srteam : Phy, Chem, Bio, Informatics Practices, English.

For 9th & 10th

Eng, Hindi, Social Studies, Science, Maths, Sanskrit and Information Technology

Medium of instructions :

The medium of instructions for Science, Maths, Phy, Chem, Bio, Information Technology and Informatics Practices is English.

Class XII (Med/Non Med)

Test for provisional admission is conducted in the first or second week of April in the subjects : Phy, Chem., Eng., Bio or Maths and Informatics Practices. The question papers in each subject is of 30 minutes duration and contains short answer type questions on the course content of class XI. Each question paper carries 20 marks. The admission is regularised after the declaration of class XI result.

Class XI (Med/Non Medical)

Test for provisional admission is conducted in the 1st or 2nd week of April in the subjects Science (40 Marks), Maths (30 Marks), and English (30 Marks) on the course content of class X. Duration for Science and Mathematics Question Paper is 45 minutes and that of English is 30 Minutes.

Pattern of Question Papers

The English question paper will contain questions on verbal comprehension (a paragraph followed by questions), picture comprehension (a picture will be printed on the question paper and the candidate will be required to write 10 sentences on it), translation from Hindi to English and vice versa.

The Question papers in Science & Maths. will contain short answer and very short answer questions.

The candidates can write the answers in Hindi or English and the question paper is also in both Hindi & English. The admission is regularised after the declaration of matric result provided the student satisfies the eligibility conditions laid down by the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh and H.P. Board of School Education.

The candidate from CBSE/ICSE and Other Board should have studied English, Hindi and Maths as elective subject in 10th class exam.

Class X

Test is conducted in the first or second week of April in the subjects : Science, Maths, Hindi, Eng. and Information Technology. The medium of test is English. Each question paper is of 30 minutes duration and carries short answer type questions on the course content of class IX. The question paper in each subject carries 20 marks.

Class IX

Test for provisional admission is conducted in the first or second week of April in the subject of Science, Maths, English and Hindi. Each paper is of 30 minutes duration and carries 25 marks. The question paper of Science and Maths is both in Hindi & English and the students have the option of writing the answer in Hindi or English. The medium of instructions for Science, Maths and Information Technology in the school is English.

The admission is regularised after the declaration of result of class VIII provided the student satisfies the eligibility conditions laid down by the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh & H.P. Board of School Education.

Classes I to VIII

The admission test is conducted in the first week of April to assess the level of learning of the student in the subjects of study of the previous class.

Pre-primary (Nursery & KG) Classes

Students are directly admitted to these classes on the first come first served basis, provided they satisfy the age and other conditions laid down by the Deptt. of Education. Minimum age for admission to Nursery class is 2½ years, for LKG is 3½ years and for UKG is 4½ years.
